DUNRICH TRUST COMPANY ACT

(Assented to _____, 1982)

WHEREAS the persons hereinafter named have by their petition prayed that this Act be enacted and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the petition;

THEREFORE HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

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| Definition | 1 In this Act, "Company" means the company incorporated by section 2. |
| Incorporation | 2 Brian Mann, D.G. Sayler, Robert W. Hladun, Robert R. Blakely and Kenneth Burton, all businessmen of the City of Edmonton, together with such persons as become shareholders of the Company, are incorporated as a corporation under the name of Dunrich Trust Company, hereinafter called "the company". |
| Provisional directors | 3 The persons named in section 2 shall be the provisional directors of the Company. |
| Capital stock | 4 The capital stock of the Company shall be \$5 000 000 divided into 500 000 shares of \$10 each. |
| Head office | 5 The head office of the Company shall be in the City of Edmonton, in the Province of Alberta. |
| Application of Trust Companies Act | 6 The Company has all the powers, privileges and immunities conferred by, and is subject to all the limitations, liabilities and provisions of the <i>Trust Companies Act</i> . |
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*In accordance with section 4(1) of the Interpretation Act,
this Bill comes into force on the date it receives Royal
Assent.*
