

An Act to Amend Chapter 41 of the Statutes of Alberta of 1907, intituled "An Act to Incorporate the Elk's Club of Calgary".

WHEREAS "The Elk's Club of Calgary" has by its petition represented that it is incorporated under Chapter 41 of the Statutes of the Province of Alberta, intituled "An Act to Incorporate the Elk's Club of Calgary" and has prayed that it be enacted as hereinafter set forth, and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said petition.

Therefore His Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:—

1. The name of the said Corporation, hereinafter called "The Corporation," is changed to "The Calgary Club", but such change of name shall not in any way impair, alter or affect the rights or liabilities of the Corporation, nor in any wise affect any suit or proceeding now pending or judgment existing either brought in favor of or against the Corporation, which notwithstanding such change in the name of the Corporation may be proceeded on to convict, complete and enforce as if this Act had not been passed.

2. This Act shall go into force on the day it is assented to.
