## BILL

No. 13 of 1910 (Second Session).

An Act to Incorporate Les Pretres du Sacre Coeur de Jesus.

(Assented to

WHEREAS an association of ecclesiastics has existed for Preunble some time in the Town of Red Deer in the Province of Alberta under the name of "Les Pretres du Sacre Cocur having for its object the establishment and carrying on of missions, the erection and conduct of schools, colleges, seminaries, churches, orphanages and hospitals;

And whereas the petition presented in their name prays that the said association may be vested with corporate powers

and it is expedient to grant their prayers:

Therefore His Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. The Reverend Eutrop Gabout, Emile Steinmetz and Incorporation Gaston Carpentier, and such other persons as are now or may hereafter become under the provisions of this Art members of the said corporation, shall be and are hereby declared to be a body politic corporate in deed and in name by the name of the "les Pretres du Sacre Coeur de Jesus," for the purposes and objects aforesaid.

- 2. The said corporation shall have perpetual succession and continues scal, and may at all times bescafter contract and continues tell still, likeliding the borrowing of measurement on managers and promissory note, see and be sued, implied and is impleaded in any matter whatsoever in all courts and plays. whatenever in this province.
- 3. All lands, tenements and hereditaments, property (real property) and personal) and all buildings, schools, colleges and convents explained belonging to, possessed or enjoyed by the said association at the time of the passing of this Act and the lands thereto pertaining shall be and the same are hereby declared to be vested in the corporation for the purpose thereof.

4. The corporation shall have power from time to time Acquisition and at all times hereafter to acouire by gift, devise, bequest, an transfer, purchase or otherwise for the benefit of the corporation of property any land or real or personal estate and the same or any part thereof may from time to time dispose of by sale, transfer or mortgage, lease, exchange or otherwise and with the proceeds therefrom may acquire other lands, tenements, hereditaments and other property (real or personal) or invest the same in any security whatsoever for the use of the corporation.

5. The revenues, issues and profits of all property (real or appropriation personal) held by the corporation shall be appropriated and of revenues applied to the maintenance of the members of the corporation and of the institutions carried on by the corporation and the construction and repair of buildings and the acquisition of property (real and personal) requisite for the purposes of the corporation and for the advancement of charity and benevolence.

6. The head office of the corporation shall be at Red Deer Head office in the Province of Alberta, or at such other place in the province as may from time to time be determined by the by-laws of the corporation.

7. The corporation may from time to time have or establish and maintain any number of branches thereof to promote the Branches objects of the corporation and for such purpose to appoint such subordinate officers with such powers and tenure of office as the corporation may deem advisable.

- 8. It shall be lawful for the corporation to make by laws, rules, orders and regulations for the government and proper avalage administration of the property, affairs and interest of the said corporation, and to repeal and amend the same from time to time.
- 9. Until otherwise directed by by-law the present existing officers of the said association shall be officers with like powers Managemen and privileges of the said corporation and the present existing rules and regulations of the said association shall mutatis mutandis be the rules and regulations of the said corporation until changed by by-law.
- 10. The said corporation shall have power to appoint one or more attorneys for such purposes as they may think fit.

  Attorneys
- 11. Unless and until the by-laws of the corporation otherwise provide all transfers, deeds of sale, leases, mortgages, and any Execution of document or paper writing whatsoever shall be executed with the seal of the corporation attested by the signature of its president, vice-president and secretary-treasurer or any two of them.
- 12. No member of the said corporation shall be individually liable or accountable for the debts, contracts or securities of necessities the said corporation.
- 13. The said corporation may exercise any industry that may help them to maintain their institution and may bargain Exercise and sell the products of the same provided they conform to the laws of the province.
- 14. Nothing herein contained shall affect the rights of His Rights of Majesty, His Heirs or successors or any other person or any corporations not affected not politic or corporate.
- 15. The corporation shall at all times, whenever required so to do by the Lieutenant Governor in Council, make a report in writing of their affairs and property.
  - 16. This Act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
