An Act to Incorporate Les Pretres du Sacre Coeur de Jesus.

(Assented to

1910.)

WHEREAS an association of ecclesiastics has existed for some time in the Town of Red Deer in the Province of Alberta under the name of "Les Pretres du Sacre Coeur de Jesus," having for its object the establishment and carrying on of missions, the erection and conduct of schools, colleges, seminaries, churches, orphanages and hospitals;

And whereas the petition presented in their name prays that the said association may be vested with corporate powers and it is expedient to grant their prayers;

Therefore His Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. The Reverend Eutrop Gabout, Emile Stemmetz and Gaston Carpentier, and such other persons as are now or may hereafter become under the provisions of this Act members of the said corporation, shall be and are hereby declared to be a body politic corporate in deed and in name by the name of the "Les Pretres du Sacre Coeur de Jesus," for the purposes and objects aforesaid.

2. The said corporation shall have perpetual succession, a common seal, and may at all times hereafter contract and transact with, including the borrowing of money on mortgage and promissory note, sue and be sued, implied and be implied in any matter whatsoever in all courts and places whatsoever in this province.

3. All lands, tenements and hereditaments, property (real and personal) and all buildings, schools, colleges and convents belonging to, possessed or enjoyed by the said association at the time of the passing of this Act and the lands thereto pertaining shall be and the same are hereby declared to be vested in the corporation for the purpose thereof.

4. The corporation shall have power from time to time and at all times hereafter to acquire by gift, devise, bequest, transfer, purchase or otherwise for the benefit of the corporation any land or real or personal estate and the same or any part thereof may from time to time dispose of by sale, transfer or mortgage, lease, exchange or otherwise and with the proceeds therefrom may acquire other lands, tenements, hereditaments and other property (real or personal) or invest the same in any security whatsoever for the use of the corporation.

5. The revenues, issues and profits of all property (real or personal) held by the corporation shall be appropriated and applied to the maintenance of the members of the corporation and of the institutions carried on by the corporation and the construction and repair of buildings and the acquisition of property (real and personal) requisite for the purposes of the corporation and for the advancement of charity and benevolence.

6. The head office of the corporation shall be at Red Deer in the Province of Alberta, or at such other place in the province as may from time to time be determined by the by-laws of the corporation. Head office

7. The corporation may from time to time have or establish and maintain any number of branches thereof to promote the objects of the corporation and for such purpose to appoint such subordinate officers with such powers and tenure of office as the corporation may deem advisable. Branches

8. It shall be lawful for the corporation to make by-laws, rules, orders and regulations for the government and proper administration of the property, affairs and interest of the said corporation, and to repeal and amend the same from time to time. By-laws

9. Until otherwise directed by by-law the present existing officers of the said association shall be officers with like powers and privileges of the said corporation and the present existing rules and regulations of the said association shall *mutatis mutandis* be the rules and regulations of the said corporation until changed by by-law. Management

10. The said corporation shall have power to appoint one or more attorneys for such purposes as they may think fit. Attorneys

11. Unless and until the by-laws of the corporation otherwise provide all transfers, deeds of sale, leases, mortgages, and any document or paper writing whatsoever shall be executed with the seal of the corporation attested by the signature of its president, vice-president and secretary-treasurer or any two of them. Execution of documents

12. No member of the said corporation shall be individually liable or accountable for the debts, contracts or securities of the said corporation. Responsibilities

13. The said corporation may exercise any industry that may help them to maintain their institution and may bargain and sell the products of the same provided they conform to the laws of the province. Exercise of industries

14. Nothing herein contained shall affect the rights of His Majesty, His Heirs or successors or any other person or any body politic or corporate. Rights of His Majesty or other corporations not affected

15. The corporation shall at all times, whenever required so to do by the Lieutenant Governor in Council, make a report in writing of their affairs and property.

16. This Act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
