An Act to Provide for the Registration of a Certain Transfer from the Alberta Railway and Irrigation Company to the City of Lethbridge of the Land Known as "Galt Park."

 $H^{\rm IS}$ MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the LegislativeAssembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. That that certain piece or parcel of land situate in the City of Lethbridge in the Province of Alberta which may be deseribed as being that certain parcel or tract of land bounded on the north by the south limit of Baroness Road; on the south by the north limit of Redpath Street; on the west by the cast limit of Round Street; on the east by the west limit of Glyn Street (excepting thereout and therefrom that portion marked "Reserve" and contained in certificate of title A.D. 89) as shown on a plan of the City of Lethbridge of record in the land titles office for the South Alberta Land Registration District as "723 D," is hereby declared to be vested in the City of Lethbridge subject to the following conditions and reservations, namely—

- (a) That the property be kept undivided and intact in perpetuity;
- (b) That the council of the city annually appropriate and expend such sum of money as the finances of the city from year to year will permit for the purpose of improving and beautifying the property by treeplanting, lawn-making and horticulture;
- (c) That the right of ingress and egress to and from the reserve in the centre (200 feet) over any part of the rest of the square be reserved, such right of ingress and egress to be located as the company may decide.

and to the proviso that in the event of breach of any of the above recited conditions the lands above described shall to the Alberta Railway and Irrigation Company.

2. The transfer of the said lands executed by the Alberta Railway and Irrigation Company to the City of Lethbridge dated the thirty-first day of August, A.D. 1909, shall be registered in the proper registry office free from any charge for assurance fund in connection therewith.
