No. 39 of 1911.

An Act for the Payment of Wages Fortnightly.

(Assented to 1911.)

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as "*The Fortnightly Pay Act.*"
2. In every city, town and village and within five miles of every city, town and village and in every other place where more than ten persons are employed wages shall be paid to every employee at intervals not exceeding fourteen days.
3. All wages due employees ceasing to work or being discharged shall be paid forthwith.
4. Every employer and every agent of an employer who contravenes the provisions of this Act shall be liable to a penalty of not less than fifty dollars.
5. This Act shall come into operation on the first day of May, nineteen hundred and twelve.
