An Act respecting the Department of Municipal Affairs.

(Assented to

1911.)

- 1. This Act may be cited as "The Department of Municipal Short Title
- 2. In this Act, unless the context otherwise requires, the Minici-expression "municipality" includes cities, towns, villages, rural municipalities, and also local improvement districts.
- 3. There shall be a department of the public service of the organization.

 Over which the Member of the Executive Council appointed by the Lieutenant Governor under the seal of the province to discharge the functions of the Minister of Municipal Affairs for the time being shall preside.
- 4. The Minister of Municipal Affairs shall be entrusted powers with the powers and charged with the duties which by any of the law in force in the province belong to the office of the Minister Minister. of Municipal Affairs.
- 5. The Lieutenant Governor in Council may appoint a Deputy officers Minister and such inspectors, clerks, assistants and other officers as may from time to time be required and provide for the remuneration of the same, and such deputy, inspectors, clerks, assistants and other officers shall do and perform a'l such acts and things relating to the business of the department as they may from time to time be directed to do and perform by the Minister.
- 6. Subject to the provisions of the various Acts from time Regulations and to time in force in Alberta respecting municipalities the Minister supplies. of Municipal Affairs shall have power to make and enforce regulations governing the methods of bookkeeping, accounting, recording and auditing to be used in the municipalities of the province; and to procure and issue to the said municipalities sample sets of books and forms which he may deem necessary for the proper carrying out of the said regulations; and to make and enforce regulations respecting such other matters and things as shall in his opinion be conducive to a thorough and systematic conduct of the affairs of the municipalities by the treasurers and other officers thereof.
- 7. The Minister of Municipal Affairs shall have power to minister settle, adjust and decide any question arising between the and adjust councils of different municipalities respecting any rights, powers cuestion. or duties conferred upon them by any Act in force in the province.

INSPECTION OF MUNICIPAL BOOKS, RECORDS AND ACCOUNTS.

8. There shall be attached to the Department of Municipal Inspection Affairs one or more inspectors whose duty it shall be from pal books

time to time as required by the Minister to examine and inspect repords all books of record and account, all bank books, assessment counts. and collection rolls and all other papers and matters whatsoever belonging to any municipality.

9. The books and records of every municipality shall be inspection so inspected at least once in every year and a special inspection null and in the case of any municipality may be ordered by the Minister when advisable on whenever he may deem it advisable or upon petition of the neglition. council of the municipality setting forth clearly the reason why in the opinion of the council such special inspection is deemed necessary.

10. Every inspector shall have power to require the attend-Power of ance of any officer of the municipality or of any other person to require whose presence he may deem necessary during the course of inspection and he shall have the same power as is exer-and others eisable by any judge or court in civil cases to compel the spection. attendance of such officer or other person before him, to compel the production of documents and to take evidence under oath.

11. When required so to do by an inspector every officer Production of the municipality shall produce for examination and in-ments. spection all books, records, papers, documents and other property of the municipality in his possession.

12. Any bank or agency of any bank carrying on business Banks to in Alberta shall upon request of an inspector acting under the satement provisions of this Act furnish him with a statement showing pal according to the satement showing the satement the balance or condition of the accounts of any municipality count having an account with such bank or agency together with any particulars of same that may be required.

13. After the completion of his inspection of the books and inspector records of any municipality it shall be the duty of the inspector to minister to make a report thereon to the Minister and to the moven. to make a report thereon to the Minister and to the mayor, overseer or reeve of the municipality in the form prescribed by the Minister.

14. In the event of any inspector reporting such a condition power of affairs in any mun cipality as in the opinion of the Minister take sumof affairs in any mun cipality as in the opinion of the Minister take warrants summary action by the municipal council with respect mary to the matters referred to in such report and sixty days elapsing without any satisfactory action being taken thereupon by the municipal council the Minister of Municipal Affairs shall deal with any and all such matters in a manner best calculated to protect and further the interests of the municipality affected; and for such purpose may if thought desirable dismiss from office the treasurer or other officer of a municipality; and in the event of any such dismissal the council shall forthwith appoint another person as treasurer or other officer in his or their place and stead.

15. The Minister of Municipal Affairs may upon the petition vuoli of the council 100ks and of the council or of one-third of the members of the council accounts of or in the case of a local improvement district, rural municipality secretary treasurers or village of twenty-five freehold electors or in case of a town of mun or city of one hundred freehold electors or burgesses denute nalities or city of one hundred freehold electors or burgesses depute one or more persons to audit the books and accounts of the treasurer of any municipality in Alberta for any particular period; and the cost of any such audit to be fixed by the Minister of Municipal Affairs shall be paid by the municipality.

- 16. It shall be the duty of every inspector to see that the Duty of inregulations made by the Minister respecting the methods of enforce rebookkeeping, accounting, recording and auditing of municipal as to bookaffairs are carried out by the officers of every municipality.

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- 17. The Minister of Municipal Affairs shall be entrusted powers with all the powers and charged with all the duties which under conferred upon The Local Improvement Act, The Village Act and The Educa-minister tional Tax Act belong to the office of the Minister of Public Works or the Tax Commissioner of the Department of Public Works.
- 18. The Minister of Municipal Affairs may deduct from all Minister taxes collected by him such percentage thereof as he may estimate to be the cost of collecting such taxes and the amounts tions. so deducted shall form part of the general revenue of the province.
