An Act respecting the Bow River Collieries Railway
Company.

(Assented to 1913.)

WHEREAS, a petition has been presented praying that it be enacted as hereinafter set forth, and it is expedient to grant the prayer of said petition;

Therefore, His Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. Notwithstanding anything contained in *The Railway Act*, or in chapter 28 of the Statutes of the Province of Alberta, 1908 (being "An Act to Incorporate the Bow River Collieries Railway Company), and notwithstanding chapter 21 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1910, passed by the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta at the first Session thereof, the time limited for the construction of the said railroad shall begin to run from the time when this Act comes into force; and for the purposes of section 68 of *The Railway Act*, the date of the incorporation of said railway company shall be deemed and taken to be the date when this Act comes into force.
