An Act to Incorporate The Town of East Calgary.

(Assented to 1913).

WHEREAS a petition has been presented by the property owners of sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 21, 22, 23 and 24, in township 24, and sections 34, 35, and 36, in Township 23, all in range 29, west of the fourth meridian, praying for the incorporation of the said lands, under the name of the Town of East Calgary, as hereinafter set forth and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said petition;

Therefore His Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- Incorporation** 1. From and after the coming into force of this Act, Sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 21, 22, 23 and 24, in township 24, and sections 34, 35 and 36, in township 23, all in range 29, west of the fourth meridian, are hereby erected and incorporated into a town under the name of the Town of East Calgary.
- Application of Towns Act.** 2. Except as hereinafter specially provided, the provisions of *The Towns Act*, and amendments thereto, are hereby incorporated with and form part of this Act.
- Qualifications of Voters at first election.** 3. The persons entitled to vote for the first mayor and council shall be all persons, male or female, over the age of 21 years, who have owned or occupied lands within the town, for a period of three months immediately prior to the date of such election.
- Local Improvement District to cease.** 4. Any local improvement district or districts contained within the limits of the town shall as and from the coming into force of this Act be disorganized, and cease to exist as a district, so far as the same is within the limits of the town:
Provided that the person who was secretary of and in such district or districts shall continue to collect such taxes as were immediately before such disorganization due such district, until notified by the Minister of Municipalities to cease, whereupon he shall hand over to the town all taxes so received by him, and all other moneys which he may have in his possession or under his control, after satisfying the liabilities of the district.
- Returning officer.** 5. Ewart Willis Baker, of near Calgary, merchant, is hereby appointed returning officer to hold the first election of the mayor and councillors of the town, and for the purpose of such election the provisions of *The Towns Act* as to elections shall *mutatis mutandis* apply.
- Expenses.** 6. All the expenses of and incidental to the procuring of this Act, and the holding of the first election shall be paid by the said town.
- Powers of Returning Officer.** 7. The returning officer for the first election shall name the places where the votes are to be polled, appoint deputy returning officers, prepare and cause to be posted up notices, and do all other acts and things necessary to be done for the holding of such election.
- Time of coming into force.** 8. This Act shall come into force the day it is assented to.
