W HEREAS the Town of Wagnwright in the Province of Alberta, have by their petition prayed that a By-law 35 of the Town of Wainwright, the certain agreement dated the 3rd day of April, A.D. 1912, made by the Town of Wainwright of the one part and Charles E. Bird of the City of Minneapolis in the State of Minneapol of the other part, in which agreement it was provided that the said Charles E. Bird should erect a flour and grist mill at the Town of Wainwright upon the conditions set forth in the said agreement and for the purpose of erecting the said mill should receive certain assistance from the Town of Wainwright, be validated and confirmed;
