An Act for the Payment of Wages Fortnightly.

(Assemted to 1913).

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as "The Fortnightly Pay Act."

2. In every city, town and village and every other place where more than ten persons are employed wages shall be paid in cash or certified cheque to every employee at intervals not exceeding former days.

3. All wages due employees easing to work or being discharged shall be paid forthwith.

4. Every employer or employers or his or their representatives who contravenes the provisions of this Act shall be liable to a penalty of not less than fifty dollars.

5. This Act shall come into force on the first day of May nineteen hundred and thirteen.
