DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL SERVICES AND COMMUNITY HEALTH AMENDMENT ACT, 1983

(Assented to , 1983)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1 The Department of Social Services and Community Health Act is amended by this Act.
- 2 The following is added after section 6:
 - **6.1**(1) The Minister may make a payment in advance from the General Revenue Fund to a person or organization providing a service under a program under the administration of the Minister for which that person or organization will be entitled to payment, if
 - (a) there is authority available in a supply vote for that service, and
 - (b) he is authorized to do so by the regulations under subsection (2).
 - (2) The Lieutenant Governor in Council may make regulations governing the conditions and circumstances under which advance payments may be made under subsection (1).
 - (3) Regulations made under subsection (2) may be specific or general in their application.
 - (4) Where the Minister makes an advance payment under this section, section 39 of the *Financial Administration Act* does not apply.
- 3 Section 11(1)(a)(viii) is repealed and the following is substituted:
 - (viii) the Family and Community Support Services Act,

In accordance with section 4(1) of the Interpretation Act, this Bill comes into force on the date it receives Royal Assent.

Explanatory Notes

- 1 This Bill will amend chapter D-27 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta 1980.
- 2 Payments in advance.

- 3 Section 11(1) presently reads in part:
 - 11(1) In this section and sections 12 to 16,
 - (a) "authorizing Act" means an Act under or pursuant to which a local authority is authorized to provide any services, money, supplies or things in the fields of health and social development and, without limitation, includes the following enactments:
 - (viii) the Preventive Social Services Act,
