### MOST GRACIOUS SOVEREIGN:

Preamble

WHEREAS it appears by Messages from His Honour, Frank Lynch-Staunton, Lieutenant Governor of the Province of Alberta, and the Estimates accompanying the Messages, that the sums hereinafter mentioned are required to defray certain expenditures of the Public Service of Alberta not otherwise provided for during the fiscal years ending respectively March 31, 1983 and March 31, 1984, and for other purposes relating thereto:

MAY IT THEREFORE PLEASE YOUR MAJESTY that it be enacted and be it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, as follows:

Appropriation for 1982-83 1 From and out of the General Revenue Fund, there may be paid and applied a sum not exceeding, in the whole, \$868 118 731.38 towards defraying the several charges and expenses of the Public Service from April 1, 1982 to March 31, 1983, not otherwise provided for and set forth in Schedule "A" to this Act.

Appropriation for 1983-84

2 From and out of the General Revenue Fund, there may be paid and applied a sum not exceeding, in the whole, \$9 489 925 968 towards defraying the several charges and expenses of the Public Service from April 1, 1983 to March 31, 1984, not otherwise provided for, being the amounts set forth in Schedule "B" to this Act, less the amount of \$3 323 674 592 voted by section 1 of the Appropriation (Interim Supply) Act, 1983.

Accountability

3 The due application of all money expended under this Act shall be accounted for.

In accordance with section 4(1) of the Interpretation Act, this Bill comes into force on the date it receives Royal Assent.
