GOVERNMENT HOUSE AMENDMENT ACT, 1983

(Assented to _____, 1983)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1 The Government House Act is amended by this Act.

2 Section 5 is amended

(a) in subsection (1) by adding the following after clause (b):

(c) with the approval of the Minister, sell, lease, exchange or otherwise dispose of any work of art acquired by the Foundation, subject to any terms or conditions on which it is held.

(b) by adding the following after subsection (1):

(1.1) Notwithstanding subsection (2), any work of art acquired by the Foundation is owned by the Foundation subject to any terms or conditions imposed in respect of the work of art when it was acquired by the Foundation.

*(1.2) Notwithstanding the *Financial Administration Act*, any money received from the sale, lease, exchange or disposition of a work of art by the Foundation belongs to the Foundation.*

(1.3) Any money received from the sale, lease, exchange or disposition of a work of art may be used by the Foundation only for the acquisition of works of art for the Foundation.

In accordance with section 4(1) of the Interpretation Act, this Bill comes into force on the date it receives Royal Assent.

Explanatory Notes

1 This Bill will amend chapter G-7 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta 1980.

2 Section 5 presently reads:

5(1) In furtherance of its objects, the Foundation may

(a) acquire personal property, whether by purchase, donation, lease, public subscription or otherwise;

(b) enter into agreements with any person respecting any matter within the objects of the Foundation.

(2) Any personal property acquired by the Foundation is owned by the Crown in right of Alberta subject to any conditions or restrictions imposed in respect of the property when it was acquired by the Foundation.
