OMBUDSMAN AMENDMENT ACT, 1983

(Assented to , 1983)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1 The Ombudsman Act is amended by this Act.

2 Section 4 is amended by striking out “and any person, if otherwise qualified, may be reappointed” and substituting “and continues to hold office after the expiry of his term of office until he is reappointed, his successor is appointed or a period of 6 months has expired, whichever occurs first”.

*In accordance with section 4(1) of the Interpretation Act,
this Bill comes into force on the date it receives Royal
Assent.*

Explanatory Notes

- 1 This Bill will amend chapter O-7 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta 1980.
- 2 Section 4 presently reads:
 - 4 *Unless his office sooner becomes vacant, a person appointed as Ombudsman holds office for 5 years*
 - (a) *from the date of his appointment under section 2, or*
 - (b) *from the date his appointment under section 7 is confirmed under that section,*

and any person, if otherwise qualified, may be reappointed.
