#### PROVINCIAL COURT AMENDMENT ACT, 1983 (NO. 2)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1 The Provincial Court Act is amended by this Act.
- 2 Section 25 is repealed and the following is substituted:
  - 25(1) A complaint under this Part may be sworn before any justice of the peace and any justice of the peace may adjourn any matter from time to time until the matter can be heard by the Court.
  - (2) A justice of the peace may exercise all duties conferred or imposed on a justice of the peace with respect to judicial interim release by or under any Act of the Legislature or the Parliament of Canada.
- 3 This Act comes into force on Proclamation.

## **Explanatory Notes**

- 1 This Bill will amend chapter P-20 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta 1980.
- 2 Section 25 presently reads:
  - 25 A complaint under this Part may be sworn before any justice of the peace authorized by the Attorney General to receive complaints under this Part and any justice of the peace so authorized may adjourn any matter from time to time until the matter can be heard by the Court.
