#### EMBLEMS OF ALBERTA AMENDMENT ACT, 1984

(Assented to

, 1984)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1 The Emblems of Alberta Act is amended by this Act.

2 Section 1(b) is amended by adding the following after subclause (vi):

(vii) the official tree of Alberta;

(viii) the official colours of Alberta.

3 The following is added after section 7:

### **Tree of Alberta**

7.1 The tree known scientifically as *Pinus contorta* variety *lati-folia* and commonly known as "lodgepole pine" is hereby adopted as the official tree of Alberta.

#### **Provincial Colours**

7.2 The following colours are hereby adopted as the official provincial colours:

blue – #286 in the Pantone International Colour Marking System

gold/deep yellow – #136 in the Pantone International Colour Marking System

In accordance with section 4(1) of the Interpretation Act, this Bill comes into force on the date it receives Royal Assent.

### **Explanatory Notes**

- 1 This Bill will amend chapter E-8 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta 1980.
- 2 Section 1 presently reads:
  - 1 In this Act,
    - (a) "Minister" means the Minister of Culture;
    - (b) "official emblem" means
      - (i) the armorial bearings of Alberta;
      - (ii) the Flag of Alberta;
      - (iii) the floral emblem of Alberta;
      - (iv) the Alberta Tartan;
      - (v) the official bird of Alberta;
      - (vi) the official stone of Alberta.
- 3 Addition of official tree and colours to present Act.
