REMEMBRANCE DAY ACT

(Assented to , 1984)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

School remembrance ceremony

- 1(1) On Remembrance Day no instruction or school activity shall take place between 11:00 a.m. and 11:05 a.m. in any school and the school shall either
 - (a) arrange for a non-demoninational remembrance ceremony to be held at the school from 11:00 a.m. to 11:05 a.m., in which case every student shall either attend the ceremony or remain in the school, silent, during its duration, or
 - (b) ensure the observance of 2 minute's silence from 11:00 a.m. to 11:02 a.m.
- (2) In a year when Remembrance Day falls on a day on which a school is not open, the provisions of subsection (1) shall apply to the day next preceding Remembrance Day on which the school is open.

2 This Act binds the Crown.
