### PUBLIC UTILITIES PLEBISCITE ACT

*(Assented to , 1984)*

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

Plebiscite held  
on public utility  
ownership

**1** The Lieutenant Governor in Council shall initiate a plebiscite under section 125 of the *Election Act* to be held in conjunction with the next plebiscite or general election of members of the Legislative Assembly, whichever first occurs, to put to the electors of the Province the question:

“Do you favour the introduction of legislation to provide for the Province to acquire all public utility companies except those already owned by the Province, a municipality or co-operative association and to appropriate funds for the acquisition?”

*In accordance with section 4(1) of the Interpretation Act, this Bill comes into force on the date it receives Royal Assent.*
