## PUBLIC UTILITIES PLEBISCITE ACT

## (Assented to , 1984)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

Plebiseite held on public utility ownership 1 The Lieutenant Governor in Council shall initiate a plebiscite under section 125 of the *Election Act* to be held in conjunction with the next plebiscite or general election of members of the Legislative Assembly, whichever first occurs, to put to the electors of the Province the question:

"Do you favour the introduction of legislation to provide for the Province to acquire all public utility companies except those already owned by the Province, a municipality or cooperative association and to appropriate funds for the acquisition?"

In accordance with section 4(1) of the Interpretation Act, this Bill comes into force on the date it receives Royal Assent.
