AN ACT TO AMEND THE MORTGAGE BROKERS REGULATION ACT

(Assented to , 1984)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1 The Mortgage Brokers Regulation Act is amended by this Act.
- 2 Section 8(1) is amended by repealing clause (a) and substituting
 - (a) the total capital to be charged, the rate of interest, the period of amortization, the repayment terms and any prepayment option of each mortgage,

In accordance with section 4(1) of the Interpretation Act, this Bill comes into force on the date it receives Royal Assent.

Explanatory Notes

- 1 This Bill will amend chapter M-19 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta 1980.
- **2** Section 8(1)(a) presently reads:
 - (a) the repayment terms of each mortgage.
