### TEMPORARY UNEMPLOYMENT MEASURES ACT

*(Assented to , 1984)*

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

Temporary

**1** Subject to the appropriation of moneys by the Legislature, the Lieutenant Governor in Council shall, immediately take all such measures as may be appropriate to provide jobs, accelerate the economy, and reduce unemployment in the Province of Alberta and, without derogating from the generality of the foregoing, the Lieutenant Governor in Council may:

- (a) accelerate the start of construction and the rate of construction of capital works projects planned by any and all departments of Government and for which moneys have been appropriated;
- (b) accelerate the start of construction and the rate of construction of capital works projects planned by any and all Crown Corporations or Agencies of the Government of Alberta and for which moneys have been appropriated;
- (c) implement a provincial parks upgrading, maintenance and capital construction program;
- (d) provide incentive grants or loans to unemployed persons in order that they may enroll in retraining and skill upgrading courses at selected Alberta educational institutions;
- (e) provide incentives to private business and industry to accelerate the construction of their planned capital construction projects;
- (f) accelerate all road construction, improvement and upgrading programs planned or proposed by the Department of Transportation;

(g) to the extent feasible, cause all Departments, Crown Corporations and Agencies to advance their anticipated stockpiling of road building, construction and other materials;

(h) develop new labour-intensive building and construction projects and programs;

(i) create joint municipal-provincial projects and programs to reduce the number of unemployed;

(j) direct the Alberta Bureau of Statistics to forthwith establish a special "unemployment statistic branch" to compile needed information on numbers of unemployed, job categories of unemployed and job potentials.
