### DINO ALBERTO KNOTT ADOPTION TERMINATION ACT

(Assented to , 1984)

Preamble

WHEREAS by order of His Honour C.G. Yanosik, in the District Court of the District of Southern Alberta, Judicial District of MacLeod, it was ordered that Dino Alberto Argento be declared to be, from and after the 19th day of May, A.D. 1972, the adopted child of Boniface Joseph Knott and Elaine Rose Knott, the Petitioners herein, and be given the surname Knott; and

WHEREAS on April 25, 1974 Dino Alberto Knott was committed to the permanent care and custody of the Director of Child Welfare, pursuant to the *Child Welfare Act*; and

WHEREAS the said order of adoption can no longer be appealed against by reason of the lapse of time and Dino Alberto Knott, now being of the full age of 18 years, has indicated his consent to the adoption being terminated; and

WHEREAS the Petitioners have by their petition prayed that it be enacted as hereinafter set forth and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the petition;

THEREFORE HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

**1** The adoption order dated May 15, 1972, and entered on the 19th day of May, 1972, whereby Dino Alberta Argento was declared to be the adopted child of Boniface Joseph Knott and Elaine Rose Knott and be named Dino Alberto Knott is hereby terminated.

**2** Dino Alberto Knott is hereby declared not to be the lawful child and heir of either Boniface Joseph Knott or Elaine Rose Knott, and not to have any rights of inheritance from Boniface Joseph Knott or Elaine Rose Knott that might otherwise devolve on him by law.
