# NEWMAN THEOLOGICAL COLLEGE AMENDMENT ACT, 1984

(Assented to , 1984)

WHEREAS the Newman Theological College was incorporated by chapter 120 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1969, which was amended by chapter 79 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1979; and

WHEREAS a petition has been presented praying that it be further amended as hereafter set forth and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the petition;

THEREFORE HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1 The Newman Theological College Act is amended by this Act.
- 2(1) "Principal" is struck out and "President" is substituted wherever it occurs in the following provisions:

(2) "vice-principal" is struck out and "vice-president" is substituted wherever it occurs in the following provisions:
