EDMONTON CONVENTION CENTRE AUTHORITY AMENDMENT ACT, 1984

(Assented to , 1984)

WHEREAS the Edmonton Convention Centre Authority was incorporated by chapter 75 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1979; and

WHEREAS the City of Edmonton has presented a petition praying that the Act be amended as herein set forth and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the petition;

THEREFORE HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1 The Edmonton Convention Centre Authority Act is amended by this Act.

2 Section 5 is amended in clause (b) by striking out "one year" and substituting "5 years".

In accordance with section 4(1) of the Interpretation Act, this Bill comes into force on the date it receives Royal Assent.

Explanatory Notes

- 1 This Bill will amend chapter 75 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1979.
- 2 Section 5(b) presently reads:
 - 5 *Without the approval of the Council the Authority shall not*
 - (b) *lease any real property for a period greater than one year;*
