## **BILL 7**

### **GLENBOW-ALBERTA INSTITUTE AMENDMENT ACT, 1985**

*(Assented to* , 1985)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

*1 The Glenbow-Alberta Institute Act is amended by this Act.*

*2 Section 3 is amended*

*(a) in subsection (1) by striking out "13" and substituting "15";*

*(b) in subsection (2) by striking out "7" and substituting "9";*

*(c) by repealing subsection (12) and substituting the following:*

*(12) Only Canadian citizens and persons who have been lawfully admitted to Canada for permanent residence are eligible to be Governors.*

*In accordance with section 4(1) of the Interpretation Act, this Bill comes into force on the date it receives Royal Assent.*

## **Explanatory Notes**

**1** This Bill will amend chapter G-5 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta 1980.

**2** Section 3 presently reads in part:

*3(1) The governing body of the Institute shall be the Board of Governors consisting of 13 Governors.*

*(2) The Lieutenant Governor in Council shall appoint 7 Governors, one of whom he shall designate as the chairman of the Board of Governors.*

*(12) To be eligible to be a Governor, a person must be*

*(a) a resident of Alberta, and*

*(b) a Canadian citizen.*
