LITTER AMENDMENT ACT, 1985

(Assented to _____, 1985)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1 *The Litter Act is amended by this Act.*

2 *Section 10 is repealed and the following is substituted:*

10(1) Where a clean up order is issued under section 9 to a local authority, the local authority may in writing request the Minister to review the order.

(2) Where a clean up order is issued under section 9 to a person other than a local authority, that person may in writing request the local authority of the municipality in which the property is located to review the order.

(3) Requests for review under subsection (1) or (2) must be made within 21 days of the date of receipt of the clean up order.

(4) A committee shall be appointed to hear requests for review under subsection (2) and the committee shall

(a) in the case of a local authority referred to in section 1(e)(i), be appointed by the local authority and include at least 1 elected member of the council or governing body of the local authority, and

(b) in the case of a local authority referred to in section 1(e)(ii), consist of those persons appointed by the Minister of Municipal Affairs or in a manner determined by him.

(5) On receiving a request for review the Minister or the committee, as the case may be, shall review the reasons for the clean up order and may confirm, rescind or vary the order.

In accordance with section 4(1) of the Interpretation Act, this Bill comes into force on the date it receives Royal Assent.

Explanatory Notes

1 This Bill will amend chapter L-19 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta 1980.

2 Section 10 presently reads:

10(1) The person to whom the clean up order is issued may, within 21 days of the date it is issued, request the Minister to review the order or any part of it.

(2) On receiving a request for review the Minister shall review the reasons for the clean up order.

(3) After conducting the review, the Minister may confirm, rescind or in any manner vary the clean up order.
