STUDENT AND TEMPORARY EMPLOYMENT ACT

(Assented to _____, 1985)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- Definitions **1** In this Act,
- (a) “employer” means an employer prescribed in the regulations;
 - (b) “job training program” means a job training program established or operated by the Minister of Manpower and prescribed in the regulations;
 - (c) “temporary job creation program” means a job creation program established or operated by the Minister of Manpower and prescribed in the regulations.
- Non-application of collective agreement **2** Notwithstanding the *Labour Relations Act* and the *Public Service Employee Relations Act*, the terms and conditions of employment of a person who is employed by an employer under a temporary job creation program or a job training program shall not be contained in a collective agreement as defined under either of those Acts.
- Regulations **3** The Lieutenant Governor in Council may make regulations
- (a) prescribing employers or classes of employers for the purpose of this Act;
 - (b) prescribing temporary job creation programs or job training programs or portions of those programs for the purpose of this Act.

In accordance with section 4(1) of the Interpretation Act, this Bill comes into force on the date it receives Royal Assent.
