MOST GRACIOUS SOVEREIGN:

Preamble

WHEREAS it appears by a Message from Her Honour, W. Helen Hunley, Lieutenant Governor of the Province of Alberta, and the Estimate accompanying the Message, that the sum hereinafter mentioned not otherwise provided for is required during the fiscal year ending March 31, 1986 for the purpose of the making of an investment pursuant to section 6(1)(a) of the Alberta Heritage Savings Trust Fund Act in a project which will provide long term economic or social benefits to the people of Alberta but which may not necessarily by its nature yield a return to the Alberta Heritage Savings Trust Fund:

MAY IT THEREFORE PLEASE YOUR MAJESTY that it be enacted and be it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, as follows:

Appropriation for 1985-86

1 From and out of the Alberta Heritage Savings Trust Fund, there may be paid and applied a sum not exceeding in the whole \$1 278 000 for the period from April 1, 1985 to March 31, 1986 for the purpose of making an investment not otherwise provided for in a project which will provide long term social and economic benefits to the people of Alberta but which may not necessarily by its nature yield a return to that Fund, being the amount of the supplementary vote by project set forth in Schedule "A" to this Act.

Accountability

2 The due application of all money expended under this Act shall be accounted for.
