## **BILL 58**

### **BANFF CENTRE AMENDMENT ACT, 1985**

(Assented to

, 1985)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1 The Banff Centre Act is amended by this Act.
- 2 Section 4 is amended
  - (a) by adding the following after subsection (2):

(2.1) The Lieutenant Governor in Council shall appoint one of the members of the board, other than the President, to be chairman of the board.

(2.2) The members of the board may elect from among themselves a person to be acting chairman in the absence or inability to act of the chairman.

(b) by adding the following after subsection (5):

(5.1) Notwithstanding subsection (5),

(a) the chairman is always eligible to be reappointed as chairman, and

(b) a member of the board, other than the President, is always eligible to be appointed chairman.

3 Section 5 is repealed.

In accordance with section 4(1) of the Interpretation Act, this Bill comes into force on the date it receives Royal Assent.

#### **Explanatory Notes**

- 1 This Bill will amend chapter B-1 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta 1980.
- 2 Section 4 presently reads in part:
  - (2) The board shall consist of
    - (a) the President, and
    - (b) 12 members appointed by the Lieutenant Governor in Council one of whom shall be nominated by the federal Minister.

(3) No person is eligible for appointment to the board unless he is a Canadian citizen or has been lawfully admitted to Canada for permanent residence.

(4) A person appointed as a member of a board

(a) holds office for a term not exceeding 3 years as prescribed in the appointment, and

(b) continues to hold office after the expiry of his term of office until he is reappointed, his successor is appointed or a period of 3 months has expired, whichever first occurs.

(5) A member appointed by the Lieutenant Governor in Council is eligible for reappointment for a 2nd term of not more than 3 years but not for a further term until the expiration of a period of 3 years after his 2nd term has expired.

**3** Section 5 presently reads:

5(1) The Lieutenant Governor in Council shall designate one of the members of the board other than the President to be chairman and that member holds office as chairman for a term of not more than 3 years and is eligible for reappointment.

(2) The chairman continues to hold office after the expiry of his term until his successor is appointed.

(3) The members of the board may elect one of their own number to be acting chairman in the absence of the chairman or in the event of the chairman's inability to act.
