RETAIL BUSINESS HOLIDAYS PLEBISCITE ACT

(Assented to , 1985)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

Plebiscite on
retail business
holidays

1 The Lieutenant Governor in Council shall order the holding of a plebiscite under section 125 of the *Election Act* to be held in conjunction with the next plebiscite or general election of members of the Legislative Assembly, whichever first occurs, to be put to the electors of the Province the question:

“Do you favour the introduction of legislation to provide that major retail business shall close on either Saturday or Sunday in each week and on statutory holidays?”

In accordance with section 4(1) of the Interpretation Act, this Bill comes into force on the date it receives Royal Assent.
