INDIGENOUS CULTURAL PROPERTIES RECLAMATION ACT

(Assented to , 1986)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1 The Foreign Cultural Property Immunity Act is amended by this Act.

2 Section 1 is amended:

(a) in clause (k) by striking out "instruments." and substituting "instruments,"; and

(b) by adding at the end of it "but does not include any property originally discovered, made, created, produced, built, crafted or constructed at a place which is now situated within the borders of the Province of Alberta."

In accordance with section 4(1) of the Interpretation Act, this Bill comes into force on the date it receives Royal Assent.

Explanatory Notes

1 This Bill will amend chapter F-12.5 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1985.

2 Section 1(k) presently reads:

1 In this Act, "cultural property" means property belonging to any one or more of the following categories:

(k) articles of furniture and musical instruments.
