INDIGENOUS CULTURAL PROPERTIES RECLAMATION ACT

(Assented to , 1986)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the
Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1 *The Foreign Cultural Property Immunity Act is amended by
this Act.*

2 *Section 1 is amended:*

(a) *in clause (k) by striking out “instruments.” and sub-
stituting “instruments,”; and*

(b) *by adding at the end of it “but does not include any
property originally discovered, made, created, produced, built,
crafted or constructed at a place which is now situated within
the borders of the Province of Alberta.”*

*In accordance with section 4(1) of the Interpretation Act,
this Bill comes into force on the date it receives Royal
Assent.*

Explanatory Notes

1 This Bill will amend chapter F-12.5 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1985.

2 Section 1(k) presently reads:

1 In this Act, “cultural property” means property belonging to any one or more of the following categories:

(k) articles of furniture and musical instruments.
