Preamble	WHEREAS the persons hereinafter named have by their petition prayed that it be enacted as hereinafter set forth, and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the petition;
	THEREFORE HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:
Company	1 William J. Pressé, business executive; Walter C. Barron, Q.C., barrister and solicitor; Stephen S. Singer, business exec- utive; Donald Douglas, business executive; Robert James Sinclair Gibson, business executive, all of the City of Calgary, together with such persons as become shareholders in the company, are incorporated under the name Oxford Trust Company Ltd., her- einafter called "the company".
Provisional directors	2 The persons named in section 1 shall be the provisional directors of the company.
Capital stock	3 The capital stock of the company shall be \$50 000 000, divided into 25 000 000 common shares without nominal or par value which may be issued for a maximum aggregate price of \$25 000 000 and 2 500 000 preferred shares of \$10 each.
Head office	4 The head office of the company shall be in the City of Calgary.

5 The company shall have all the powers, privileges and immunities conferred by, and is subject to all the limitations, liabilities, and provisions of the *Trust Companies Act*.

Powers

In accordance with section 4(1) of the Interpretation Act, this Bill comes into force on the date it receives Royal Assent.
