TIMOTHY Z. MARSHALL BAR ADMISSION ACT

(Assented to , 1986)

WHEREAS Timothy Z. Marshall, a British subject and resident of Bermuda, cannot practice law in Bermuda until he has been admitted to the Bar of a Commonwealth jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS Timothy Z. Marshall accepted articles with a Calgary law firm in March 1984 during which time British subjects were eligible to be called to the Alberta Bar pursuant to the *Legal Profession Act*, being chapter L-9 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta 1980; and

WHEREAS the *Legal Profession Act* was subsequently amended thereby disentitling British subjects from being admitted to the Alberta Bar; and

WHEREAS a petition has been presented praying for the admission of Timothy Z. Marshall to the Alberta Bar, and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the petition;

THEREFORE HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1 Notwithstanding section 39(2) of the *Legal Profession Act*, the Secretary of the Law Society of Alberta shall approve the enrolment of Timothy Z. Marshall as a member of the Law Society if he proves to the Secretary's satisfaction and in accordance with the rules of the Society that he

- (a) is a British subject,
- (b) is of the full age of 18 years,
- (c) has served under articles for a continuous period of at least 1 year or, with the approval of the Law Society Benchers, for a period totalling at least 1 year,
- (d) has passed a bar admission examination, and
- (e) has passed any special examinations that the Co-ordinating Council of Alberta may require him to take, if his degree in law was not granted by a university in Alberta.

2 In all other respects, the provisions of the *Legal Profession Act* govern Timothy Z. Marshall's admission to the Alberta Bar.

In accordance with section 4(1) of the Interpretation Act, this Bill comes into force on the date it receives Royal Assent.
