### **EMBLEMS OF ALBERTA AMENDMENT ACT, 1987**

*(Assented to \_\_\_\_\_, 1987)*

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1 The Emblems of Alberta Act is amended by this Act.*
- 2 Section 3(3) is amended by striking out “Government Specifications” and substituting “General Standards”.*
- 3 Section 7.2 is amended*
  - (a) by striking out “#286 in the Pantone International Colour Marking System” and substituting “Canadian General Standards Board, standard 1-GP-12c, 202-101”;*
  - (b) by striking out “#136 in the Pantone International Colour Marking System” and substituting “Canadian General Standards Board, standard 1-GP-12c, 505-311.*

## Explanatory Notes

**1** This Bill will amend chapter E-8 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta 1980.

**2** Section 3 presently reads in part:

*(3) The blue of the Flag shall be a shade of blue conforming with the Canadian Government Specifications Board, Specification 1-GP-12c-PII, 1965: Standard paint colour-blue 202-101.*

**3** Section 7.2 presently reads:

*7.2 The following colours are hereby adopted as the official provincial colours:*

*blue — #286 in the Pantone International  
Colour Marking System*

*gold/deep yellow — #136 in the Pantone International  
Colour Marking System*
