ASSESSMENT APPEAL BOARD AMENDMENT ACT, 1987

(Assented to , 1987)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1 The Assessment Appeal Board Act is amended by this Act.
- 2 Section 2(1) is amended by striking out "not more than 6" and substituting "those".
- 3 Section 3 is amended
 - (a) in subsections (1)(c) and (3) by adding "or more" after "2";
 - (b) in subsection (5) by striking out "the other division" and substituting "1 or more other divisions".

Explanatory Notes

- 1 This Bill will amend chapter A-46 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta 1980.
- 2 Section 2(1) presently reads:
 - 2(1) There shall be a board to be known as the Alberta Assessment Appeal Board which shall be composed of not more than 6 persons appointed by the Lieutenant Governor in Council, each of whom shall hold office during pleasure.
- 3 Section 3 presently reads in part:
 - 3(1) The members of the Board shall, at the direction of the chairman, sit as
 - (a) the Board,
 - (b) a division of the Board, or
 - (c) 2 divisions of the Board.
 - (3) The Board may sit in 2 divisions simultaneously or at different times.
 - (5) When a division of the Board, at which a quorum is present, sits, whether by itself or simultaneously with the other division of the Board, a decision or action of the division is the decision or action of the Board and binds all members of the Board.
