AN ACT TO AMEND THE PHARMACEUTICAL ASSOCIATION ACT

(Assented to , 1987)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1 The Pharmaceutical Association Act is amended by this Act.
- 2 Section 59 is amended by striking out "may use a drug or drug combination" and substituting "shall use the least expensive drug or drug combination available to the pharmaceutical chemist".

Explanatory Notes

- 1 This Bill will amend chapter P-7 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta 1980.
- 2 Section 59 presently reads as follows:
 - 59 When a prescription refers to a drug or drug combination by a brand name or a name other than its generic name, a pharmaceutical chemist, in dispensing the prescription, may use a drug or drug combination that is the generic or brand name equivalent of that named in the prescription unless the prescriber indicates otherwise
 - (a) by designating the name of the manufacturer, or
 - (b) by specifying that no equivalent is to be dispensed.
