## **BILL 274**

### **SCHOOL USER FEES ELIMINATION ACT**

*(Assented to , 1987)*

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the  
Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1 The School Act is amended by this Act.*
- 2 Section 72(4) is amended:*
  - (a) in clause (k) by striking out “sell, rent and”, and*
  - (b) in clause (l) by striking out “and charge tuition fees and transportation fees for children attending the program”.*
- 3 Section 147(c) is amended by striking out “or otherwise”.*
- 4 Section 152(2) is repealed.*

## Explanatory Notes

**1** This Bill will amend chapter S-3 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta 1980.

**2** Section 72(4)(k) and (l) presently reads:

*(4) A board, subject to this Act and the regulations, may*

*(k) sell, rent and distribute instructional materials and supplies to teachers and pupils;*

*(l) provide for an early childhood services program in accordance with the regulations under the department of Education Act and charge tuition fees and transportation fees for children attending the program.*

**3** Section 147(c) presently reads:

*147 Notwithstanding anything in this Part a board may*

*(c) arrange for, undertake or sponsor, for its pupils and at its own cost or otherwise, educational, cultural or recreational trips inside or outside its district and division.*

**4** Section 152(2) presently reads:

*(2) A board may charge tuition fees for any pupil whose parent is not a resident of the district or division but the fee shall not exceed the amount of the net average local cost per pupil of maintaining the program in which the pupil is enrolled.*

5 *Section 164(3) is repealed.*

6 *This Act comes into force on January 1, 1988.*

**5** Section 164(3) presently reads:

*(3) A board may charge any fees it determines for any course established by it.*

**6** Coming into force.
