### **THE KING'S COLLEGE AMENDMENT ACT, 1987**

*(Assented to , 1987)*

WHEREAS The King's College was incorporated by the King's College Act, being chapter 77 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1979; and

WHEREAS a petition has been presented praying that the Act be amended as hereinafter set forth and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the petition;

THEREFORE HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

*1 The King's College Act is amended by this Act.*

*2 Section 3 is repealed and the following is substituted:*

**3** The College shall have the power to establish and conduct in the Province a Christian college to afford instruction in the liberal arts, theology, sciences, education and such other fields as the Board of Governors may from time to time determine.

## **Explanatory Notes**

### **Preamble**

**1** This Bill will amend chapter 77 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1979.

**2** Section 3 presently reads as follows:

*3 The College shall have the power to establish and conduct in the Province a Christian college to afford instruction in the liberal arts, theology, sciences and education.*
