### **POLISH CANADIAN CULTURAL CENTRE OF CALGARY ACT**

*(Assented to , 1988)*

Preamble

WHEREAS the Polish Canadian Cultural Centre of Calgary has presented a petition praying that it be enacted as herein set forth and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the petition;

THEREFORE HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

Taxation  
exemption

**1** The following lands and building in the City of Calgary, which are leased from the City of Calgary and owned by the Polish Cultural Centre of Calgary pursuant to a lease for a term of 40 years from October 1, 1983 and described as follows:

PLAN SOUTH AIRWAYS INDUSTRIAL PARK  
CALGARY 7911468  
BLOCK TWO (2)  
LOT SIX (6)

CONTAINING 1.12 HECTARES (2.27 ACRES) MORE  
OR LESS

EXCEPTING THEREOUT ALL MINES AND  
MINERALS

shall be exempt from all municipal and school taxes of every nature whatsoever, with effect from January 1, 1988, for so long as the Polish Canadian Cultural Centre of Calgary has an interest in the said lands as a leaseholder or registered owner and the same are used for the provision of educational, recreational, social and cultural facilities to the Polish Canadian community and other residents of the City of Calgary on a non-profit basis, and for the enhancement and promotion of multiculturalism in Alberta.
