DONALD ROY DEEN COMPENSATION ACT

(Assented to , 1988)

Preamble

WHEREAS in October, 1970 Donald Roy Deen was seriously injured in a motor vehicle accident in Alberta, while acting within the scope of his employment as a salesman of Vancouver, British Columbia; and

WHEREAS at the time of the said accident his employer, a British Columbia corporation, was not an employer under *The Workmen's Compensation Act* of Alberta, nor was Donald Roy Deen covered by *The Workmen's Compensation Act* of British Columbia as his employment and residence was outside of British Columbia; and

WHEREAS on or about the 1st day of February, 1971 his employer became an industry to which *The Workmen's Compensation Act* of Alberta applied; and

WHEREAS Donald Roy Deen has presented a petition praying that it be enacted as herein set forth, and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the petition;

THEREFORE HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

Deemed
coverage

1 Donald Roy Deen is deemed to have been covered for compensation under *The Workmen's Compensation Act* at the time of his injury in October, 1970 and to be entitled to the benefits for such injuries provided by statute.
