FAMILY DAY ACT

(Assented to , 1989)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

Family Day

1 In recognition of the importance of the family, the 3rd Monday in February in each year shall be observed as a public holiday and known as "Alberta Family Day".

Consequential

2 The Employment Standards Code is amended by adding the following after section 1(1)(g)(i):

(i.1) Alberta Family Day,

Consequential

3 The Interpretation Act is amended in section 25(1)(i.1)(ii) by adding ", Alberta Family Day" after "New Year's Day".

Coming into force

4 This Act comes into force on February 19, 1990.
