DEPARTMENT OF CULTURE AND MULTICULTURALISM AMENDMENT ACT, 1989

(Assented to , 1989)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1 The Department of Culture and Multiculturalism Act is amended by this Act.
- 2 Section 9 is amended
 - (a) in subsection (2) by striking out "and" at the end of clause (a) and by adding the following after clause (a):
 - (a.1) supplies, material, equipment and remuneration related to the provision of ushers, coat checkers, ticket takers and related supervisory staff at the Northern Alberta Jubilee Auditorium at Edmonton and the Southern Alberta Jubilee Auditorium at Calgary, and
 - (b) by adding the following after subsection (3):
 - (3.1) The Minister may pay into the revolving fund the revenue obtained from the provision of services referred to in subsection (2)(a.1), but the amount so paid shall not exceed the amount specified for those services in a rental fee schedule approved by the Minister.
 - (c) by repealing subsection (5) and substituting the following:
 - (5) The amount of the proceeds of a sale, lease or disposition made under subsection (4) and any amounts paid into the revolving fund under subsection (3.1) shall be credited in reduction of the amount of the advances made by the Provincial Treasurer under subsection (2).
- 3 This Act is deemed to have come into force on June 1, 1989.

Explanatory Notes

- 1 This Bill will amend chapter D-15 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta 1980.
- 2 Section 9 presently reads in part:
 - 9(1) The Minister shall establish and administer a revolving fund for the Department of Culture and Multiculturalism.
 - (2) The Provincial Treasurer shall, on the requisition of the Minister, advance from and out of the General Revenue Fund to the revolving fund administered by the Minister the money required from time to time by the Minister to pay for
 - (a) supplies, material, equipment and remuneration required to operate
 - (i) the commissaries at the Northern Alberta Jubilee Auditorium at Edmonton and the Southern Alberta Jubilee Auditorium at Calgary, and
 - (ii) any bookstore under the administration of the Minister,

and

- (b) salaries and wages of employees required to administer the operations of the revolving fund.
- (3) The net amount outstanding at any time in respect of advances under subsection (2) shall not exceed \$1 000 000.
- (4) The Minister may sell, lease or otherwise dispose of supplies, material and equipment purchased out of the revolving fund on the terms and conditions that the Minister considers proper.
- (5) The amount of the proceeds of a sale, lease or disposition made under subsection (4) shall be credited in reduction of the amount of the advances made by the Provincial Treasurer under subsection (2).
- 3 Coming into force.
