MOTOR VEHICLE SALES ACT

(Assented to , 1989)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows: ,

Definitions	1 In this Act,
	(a) "motor vehicle" means a motor vehicle as defined in the <i>Motor Vehicle Administration Act</i> ;
	(b) "seller" means any person who in the course of business sells, offers or displays a motor vehicle for sale either in the capacity of owner, agent or as a person having legal authority to sell the vehicle, or an agent or employee of any such person. and "sell" has a corresponding meaning.
Price displayed	2 Every seller shall ensure that a motor vehicle being offered or displayed for sale is clearly marked with the price.
Posted price	3 Nothing in this Act prevents a sale of a motor vehicle at a price less than that marked.
Offences and penalties	4 A person who fails to comply with section 2 is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding \$500.
