AN ACT TO AMEND THE EMBLEMS OF ALBERTA ACT

(Assented to , 1989)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1 The Emblems of Alberta Act is amended by this Act.

2 Section 1(b) is amended by adding the following after subclause (viii):

(ix) the official mammal of Alberta.

Explanatory Notes

1 This Bill will amend chapter E-8 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta 1980.

- 2 Section 1(b) presently reads:
 - (b) "official emblem" means
 - (i) the armorial bearings of Alberta;
 - (ii) the Flag of Alberta;
 - (iii) the floral emblem of Alberta;
 - (iv) the Alberta Tartan;
 - (v) the official bird of Alberta;
 - (vi) the official stone of Alberta;
 - (vii) the official tree of Alberta;
 - (viii) the official colours of Alberta.

3 The following is added after section 7.2:

Mammal of Alberta

7.3 The mammal known scientifically as Ovis canadensis and commonly known as the "Rocky Mountain Big Horn Sheep" is hereby adopted as the official mammal of Alberta.

New section establishes the Rocky Mountain Big Horn Sheep as the official mammal of Alberta.
