## **BILL 231**

### **SPACE AGENCIES ACT**

*(Assented to , 1989)*

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the  
Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

**Definitions**

**1** In this Act,

- (a) "Centre" means the Space Agencies Centre created pursuant to section 2 of this Act;
- (b) "Minister" means the Minister of Technology, Research and Telecommunications;

**Corporation  
established**

**2(1)** There is hereby established a corporation with the name "Alberta Space Agencies Centre".

(2) The Centre shall be managed by a Board of Directors appointed pursuant to section 3.

**Board of  
Directors**

**3** The Minister shall appoint 7 persons to be members of the Board of whom at least

- (a) one shall be a Member of the Legislative Assembly;
- (b) one shall be from the academic staff of a university in Alberta;
- (c) 2 shall represent industries in Alberta that are involved in technology;

Objects

**4** The objects of the Centre are

- (a) to promote the development of high technology related to space or which needs space conditions;
- (b) to encourage co-operative ventures between the research and industrial communities in Alberta;
- (c) to promote career development in high technology which is space related.

Funds

**5** The Board may receive, hold and disburse funds which are made available to it either as a result of an appropriation by the Legislature or from other sources, to achieve the objects of the Centre.

Agreements

**6** The Centre may enter into agreements providing for research and development in high technology related to space or for the development and distribution of educational and career related materials in that field.
