## AN ACT TO AMEND THE INTERPROVINCIAL LOTTERY ACT (No.2)

(Assented to , 1990)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1 The Interprovincial Lottery Act is amended by this Act.
- 2 The following is added after section 5:

**5.1(1)** During every session of the Legislature, after the presentation of the Estimates to the Assembly by the Provincial Treasurer and before the introduction of the annual Appropriation Act, the Minister shall table in the Legislative Assembly a budget for the Fund for the forthcoming fiscal year.

(2) The budget shall show the expected receipts of the Fund, the proposed costs of administering the Fund and the proposed disbursements from the Fund under section 6.

(3) The Minister shall propose a resolution to the Assembly providing for the Assembly to approve the budget.

(4) If at any time after the passage of a resolution pursuant to subsection (3), the Minister wishes to report further receipts, administrative costs or proposed further disbursements from the Fund he shall present a supplementary budget in the form described in subsection (2) and propose a further resolution for the Assembly to approve the supplementary budget.

3 Section 6 is amended by adding the following at the end of it:

"providing that the Minister has included the proposed

in a budget or supplementary budget presented to the Legislative Assembly and the Legislature has approved it or the expenditure is authorized by a special warrant detailing the purpose of the expenditure".
