OPEN TAXATION ACT

(Assented to , 1990)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1 In this Act,

Definitions

(a) "goods or services" includes only those to which a sales tax applies;

(b) "vendor" means a person who sells goods or services or offers them for sale.

Tax shown separately
2 A vendor who marks or publishes the price of goods or services, shall show the price without sales tax and the amount of sales tax separately.

Separate record of tax
3 A vendor shall, in respect of every sale of goods or a service, provide to the purchaser an invoice or a receipt for the sale that shows separately the amount of sales tax payable or paid.

Offences and penalties 4 A vendor who fails to comply with this Act is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to a fine of not more than \$500.

Exemptions 5 The Minister of Consumer and Corporate Affairs may issue regulations exempting vendors or classes of vendors from the provisions of this Act.
