AN ACT TO AMEND THE LIQUOR CONTROL ACT

(Assented to , 1990)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1 The Liquor Control Act is amended by this Act.*
- 2 The following is added after section 95:*

95.1 A person who suffers injury or loss as a result of having been or of some other person having been served alcohol in contravention of section 95(2), the person suffering injury or loss has a cause of action against the licensee or permittee, employee or agent who sold or provided liquor in contravention of section 95(2) and, if the court is of the opinion that the injury or loss resulted wholly or partly from the alcohol being so served, the court may order all or any of the licensee, permittee, employee or agent to pay all or a part of the damages assessed by the court in respect of the injury or loss.

Explanatory Notes

- 1** This Bill will amend chapter L-17 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta 1980.
- 2** Adds a new section which will allow civil action to be brought for damages against anyone who serves alcohol in contravention of the Act, particularly to those who are apparently intoxicated or under the influence of drugs and to include them in full or proportional liability in respect of the award of damages.
